NUST Health Services in conjunction with the Cancer Association of Namibia will conduct a clinic on Pap Smear and Breast Examinations.

The objectives are to:

- Make women aware that cervical cancer can only be detected by a pap smear and if diagnosed early it can be cured;
- Sensitize women who are sexually active, regardless of their age or marital status to undergo a pap smear annually;
- Inform women that by breast examinations lumps can be detected early and be treated; and
- Inform woman also that the test will reveal and often the type of infection present in the vagina.
