3. No IDs, Passports or Drivers' Licenses will be accepted at the venues.
4. A semester mark of at least 40% is required to gain admission to the examination.
5. Lost or Damaged Student Cards (photo or student number not clear) must be replaced with new cards at the ICT Department. Otherwise you will not be allowed to sit for the examinations.
6. Practical exams will be written in the relevant labs. Students should contact their lecturers for exact start times and the labs to be used.
7. **BSC410S on 30 OCT at 08:00 is for students who offer the course on Distance and Part time modes only. Students offering BSC410S on Full time mode write at 13H00.**
8. EPR511S on 01 NOV at 08:00 is for Distance students only. Full time and Part time students write at 13:00.
9. EAP511S on 02 NOV at 13:00 is for Distance students only. Full time and Part time students write at 18:00.
10. PWR611S on 06 NOV at 13:00 is for Distance students only. Full time and Part time students write at 18:00.
11. **Students with disabilities or special needs should contact the Examination Department in good time to make the necessary arrangements.**
12. Students who are in debt with NUST must contact the Finance Department in good time.
13. Cell phones or any other devices with text or digital facilities are NOT allowed inside the examination venues.
